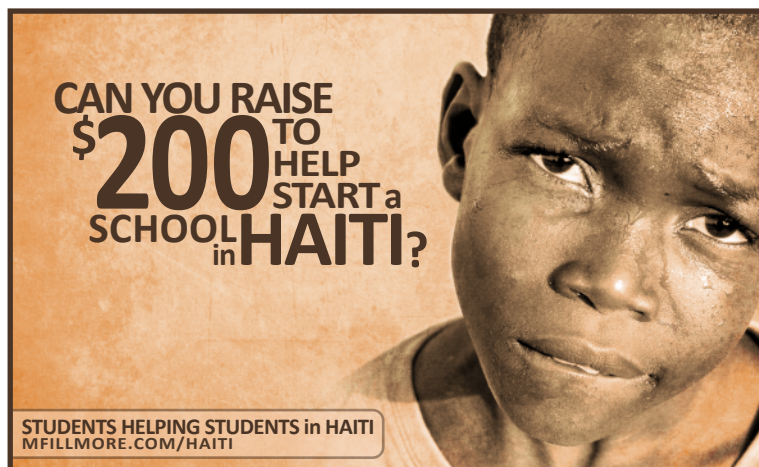


STUDENTS HELPING STUDENTS in HAITI



Dear Friend,
First off, I just wanted to say that I'm honored that you have decided to join me in this opportunity to raise support for a school in the village of Guitton, Haiti. We are in this together! My goal is to raise a total of \$20,000 by January 1, 2011, in order to start this school as soon as next Fall! It's a great opportunity for all of us to "look not only to our own interests, but also to the interests of others" in Haiti (Phil. 2:4).

So, it's exciting to know that we are a part of starting the *very first* school in the village of Guitton!
